


Why make online video accessible (short)

- International guidelines (W3C WCAG2.0)
- Iaws and regulations: Section508, EU Directives, UN Convention, EU Meberstates laws/regulations
- Increased searchability (Google)
- Solution Lower TCO (thus a businesscase)
- Government/education etc. should be accessible for all citizens that can use the web
- Solt is the trend...



## Making online video accessible, how hard is that?





- Sirst: Do you (always) need Captions?
- So Then: How do you make captions?

# Use Closed Captions: MAGpie, Subtitle Workshop etc. are free for use





#### So First: Do you (always) need Audio Description?

#### S EXAMPLE WHAT IS THIS VIDEO ABOUT???

Then: How do you make audio description?Windows Movie Maker? Studio?







#### Solution Put the files online:

- (1) the video file,
- (2) the caption file (mostly a .srt or .tt file) and
- (3) the mp3 file with the audio description.
- Install the player: We use the Jeroen Wijering Accessible player.
- Do it yourself next weekend: Unpack the player and the script and follow the easy step by step installation procedure. This should not take more than 30 minutes. Fill in the filenames in the page and you can play the video. This will work on any computer that can already play Youtube videos.





- Provide alternative layers
- (1) Provide the video with open (instead of closed) captions and with audio description added to the soundtrack.
- (2) Provide all the separate files for download:
  videofile, captions file and audio description file
- (3) Provide a SMIL file with the separate files (see option 2) for download.

Using SMIL would be best.
